

GAMMILL INFORMATION

GAMMILL PRE-RENTAL CLASS

For those of you who would like to quilt on a Gammill, but do not own one, this is the perfect class for you. This class consists of a series of three, three-hour classes designed to give you the skills to be able to use the Gammill without any supervision. The first session will acquaint you with the workings of the machine. The other two sessions will consist of quilting using either a pattern or free-motion quilting. We now offer rental time on the Gammill, but you will be required to complete at least two of the three sessions of this class in order to rent time. The session related to acquainting you with the machine is one of the two classes that must be completed prior to renting time on the machine. You have the option of completing either one of the other two sessions or both sessions before renting time on the machine. In addition, if you complete two sessions, you will receive two free hours of rental time on the machine and if you complete all three sessions, you will receive three free hours of rental time on the machine.

Class fee is \$175.00 for two sessions or \$250.00 for three sessions.

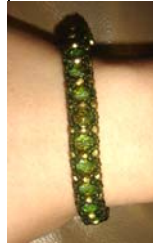


BEADING CLASSES

Try an easy variation on the RAW stitch using fire polished Czech glass and seed beads. We'll have 2 colors: green or light plum/copper. All skill levels.
