



Gone to Texas

Class Supplies:

1. The book "Gone to Texas" by Betsy Chutchian. We will be doing the quilt on page 34.
2. Sewing machine and general sewing supplies
3. Fit to Be Square Ruler
4. A couple of general rulers. I like the 6-1/2" square ruler and the 12-12" ruler.
5. Small ruler and sharp pencil or Sharpie to mark you sewing lines
6. The Angler (optional-if you want to use this to sew your flying geese units together)
7. I also used the following Thangles FINISHED sizes: 1-1/2"; 1-3/4", 2-1/2", and 3" finished sizes. I found it convenient to just cut them apart and use them. For the first class, we will use the 1-3/4" and 1-1/2" finished size.
8. Paper scissors
9. Optional is the Judy Martin Point Trimmer.

Fabric Requirements:

As outlined on page 36. This quilt takes a lot of scrap fabrics so it is a good quilt to use up those small pieces that you have been saving.

Homework prior to class:

Our goal will be to make one Delectable Union block and the Odd block in class. Please pick out fabric for both of these blocks. The Delectable Union block is made up of one Union Block with 4 corners on each side. I used the Fit to Be Square ruler and oversized cut the triangles and trimmed them to finish the correct size. Please **PRECUT ACCORDING TO THE DIRECTIONS BELOW FOR EACH BLOCK:**

One Union Block (page 36):

- (1) 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" square (A)
- (2) 5 x 5" squares; cut again once diagonally (B)
- (8) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares (C)
- (4) 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" squares (D)
- (4) 2-1/4" x 4" rectangles (E)

I then used the 1-3/4" Thangles to pair up a background fabric (F) and (C) units to make 8 pairs. These could be all the same or different depending on your preference. I made some all the same and some different in replicating the blocks.

Delectable Union corner sections (page 37):

Note: I treated each corner section individually. You may make all yours the same; if you wish to do this, then you will need to cut enough to make 4 units. I have listed the cutting directions for just one unit.

(1) 2" x 2" square (A)

(1) 2-3/8" x 2-3/8" squares, cut again once diagonally (B)

(1) 5-3/8" x 5-3/8" squares, cut again once diagonally (C)

I then used the 1-1/2" Thangles to pair up a background fabric (B) and (D) units to make 6 pairs.

Odd Block (page 37):

(1) 5-3/4" x 5-3/4" square (A)

(2) 5-1/4" x 5-1/4" squares, cut again once diagonally (B)

(4) 3" x 3" squares (C)

(2) 2-5/8" x 2-5/8" squares, cut again once diagonally (D)

(2) 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares, cut again once diagonally (E)

After the Odd Block is made; you then need to make 4 Delectable Union corners to surround it. We only make one of this block.
