Class Supplies:

1. The book "Layer Cake, Jelly Roll, and Charm Quilts" by Pam & Nicky Lintott. We will be doing the quilt on page 64
2. Sewing machine and general sewing supplies
3. Quilting ruler with a 60 degree angle - I like the Creative Grids rectangle ruler that is 6-1/2" x 18-1/2". You need to use a rectangle ruler as the square rulers do not have the correct angle.
4. Rotary cutter and mat board.
5. Best Press - very helpful to use when piecing quilts with bias edges.

Fabric Requirements:

As outlined on page 64. You will need for 7/8 yard for the first border and 5/8 yard for binding fabric.

Homework prior to class:

Cut your layer cakes in half (you will be two 5" x 10" pieces). We will do the rest of the cutting in class.

NOTE: I did not especially like the pieced border. I found it difficult to make all of them the same size. You are welcome to try it in class and make a decision. I would simply add another border of different fabric to the outside. If you want to leave off the pieced border, buy another border fabric of 1-1/4 yards.
