



Textured Tote

Supplies Needed

1. *Textured Tote* pattern and package of Texture Magic
2. Sewing machine
3. Walking Foot (optional)
4. Jeans/Denim (90/14) needle
5. General Sewing Supplies
6. Rotary cutter and rulers
7. Fabric requirements as outlined on the pattern
8. Thread to match fabric for topstitching

To Do Prior to Class

Cut out fabric as instructed by the pattern. Prepare your fabric for quilting as instructed by the pattern in step A. If you would like your bag to look like mine, put a layer of fusible fleece or batting between the Texture Magic and fabric. If you are going to do intricate quilting, please quilt before class. If you are going to do simple quilting, you can do this in class. If you do quilt your fabric prior to class, DO NOT texturize it or get near it with an iron until class! Also, I did not use Headliner foam or batting in my handles, I used fusible fleece cut the same size as the handles. If you wish to add pockets, please bring along some extra fabric and fleece! I cut my pockets 11x7" with the fleece cut 5.5x7".
