

Civil War Tribute



As we approach the 150-year commemoration of the American Civil War in 2011, Marcus Fabrics and Judie Rothermel have partnered with Homestead Hearth to create a very special block of the month program. The quilt features fabric designed by Judie Rothermel, coupled with Homestead Hearth's original quilt design, based on classic quilt blocks and variations. The result is a beautifully detailed quilt measuring a generous 100" x 112". The Civil War Tribute quilt highlights a variety of sawtooth and star blocks. Each of the quilt blocks represents a major battle fought during the war.

Join us to make this spectacular quilt! Monthly kits will be available for \$25/month. Class sessions will discuss the block construction for the month, but are optional.

Laurie Hird has excerpted 55 of the top letters and, using these letters as inspiration, has created 111 traditional 6" quilt blocks and arranged them in a tribute quilt. The book gives hand piecing templates for the blocks, so in class we will discuss alternative piecing methods for the blocks including rotary cutting and paper piecing. Fee: \$50.00 for the year.
