



# Beginning Machine Quilting

## Supplies needed:

1. Sewing machine - must be able to drop or cover feed dogs
2. Walking foot for your machine and free motion foot (sometimes called a darning foot on older machines) to use for free motion quilting
3. Machine needles: Size 80/12
4. Thread: Invisible thread (either clear or smoke); light weight (size 60) machine embroidery thread for the bobbin (any color); and 1 or 2 colored or variegated threads for variety to use for free motion quilting
5. Two yards of muslin
6. One crib size Hobbs fusible batting or fusible fleece (a piece of at least 1-1/2" yards)
7. One yard of large print overall floral with large flowers
8. General sewing supplies: scissors, pins, pencil, etc

## Prior to class, please do the following:

1. Cut muslin as follows:
  - a. Cut one piece 30" x 45"
  - b. Cut four pieces 18" x 18" square
2. Cut large floral print the same as the muslin; 30" x 45"
3. Cut batting as follows:
  - a. Cut one piece 30" x 45"
  - b. Cut two pieces 18" x 18" square
4. Iron muslin to batting to make two 18" quilt sandwiches, i.e., muslin, batting, muslin; muslin, batting muslin
5. Iron large floral, batting, and muslin together
