



String Quilt

Class Supplies:

1. The book "String Quilt Revival" by Virginia Baker & Barbara Sanders. The sample was based on the quilt Diamonds are Forever on page 54. You may do any quilt in the book.
2. Sewing machine and general sewing supplies
3. No-show mesh stabilizer designed for machine embroidery. I have some that I can share.
4. 12-1/2" square ruler
5. Rotary cutter and mat
6. Small portable iron and pressing mat
7. Plastic template material and sharpie marker (depending on which quilt you are making). Some quilts in the book are simply from strips and no templates or marking is required.

Fabric Requirements:

As outlined for the particular quilt you want to do in the book.

Homework prior to class:

Cut your strips into different widths as outlined for the quilt you pick. I also cut my stabilizer a little larger than required and squared it up after I made all of them. I would recommend doing the same thing.

The sample had a total of 48 blocks with a 6-1/2 wide border on the outside.

I'm bringing the soup and fabric strips that you are welcome to use. Bring whatever else you want to snack on and a drink.

Trading strips is optional during class but will guarantee an interesting quilt!
